National High School Rodeo Association

The National High School Rodeo Association (NHSRA) is an international, non-profit organization dedicated to the development of sportsmanship, horsemanship and the sport of rodeo. Created by Texas educator and rodeo contestant Claude Mullins. In 1947 Mr. Mullins saw the need for a program that would encourage youth to pursue further education. The NHSRA held its first finals in Hallettsville, Texas, in 1947. Since then the NHSRA membership has expanded to over 13,000 members from 42 states, five Canadian provinces and Australia.

The National High School Rodeo Association is governed by National Directors. NHSRA National Directors are comprised of one representative from each state / provincial association. They also take the responsibility for planning of the National Board of Directors and are dedicated to the success of the NHSRA and the NJHFR and NHSFR each year.

Ontario High School Rodeo Association

The OHSRA is proud to be a part of the National High School Rodeo Association (NHSRA) and is governed by an elected volunteer board of directors at the adult level and an elected executive at the student level.

The OHSRA stresses the importance of education and sportsmanship by teaching life skills such as leadership, responsibility, dedication, and commitment. As support and continuing education is high priority to the High School Rodeo Association, we offer scholarship to successful applicants and encourage our youth to strive for excellence both in and out of the rodeo arena.

OHSRA members compete at provincial level for local recognition. The top 4 from each event in both Jr and High School levels have the opportunity to go onto the National level and compete in the NJHFR or the NHSFR.

High School Division



Today the NHSRA is one of the most active and premier youth organizations in North America. The NHSRA is the largest rodeo association in the world, it sanctions more than 1,800 rodeos in the membership states and provinces each year. It also hosts the National Junior High Finals Rodeo (NJHFR) each year in June and the world largest rodeo The National High School Finals Rodeo (NHSFR) every JULY. Both of these rodeos change locations every two years, and awards championships in both girls and boys events as well as numerous scholarships.

Girls Rodeo Events

There are 10 events the girls can compete in for high school rodeo. They are Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Goat Tying, Breakaway Roping, Cutting, the Queen Competition, Team Roping, Reined Cow Horse, Light Rifle Competition and Skeet Shooting Competition.

Boys Rodeo Events

There are 10 events the boys can compete in. These are Bull Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding, Bareback Riding, Steer Wrestling, Tie Down Roping, Cutting, Team Roping, Reined Cow Horse, Light Rifle Competition and Skeet Shooting Competition.

Junior High Division



In 2004 NHSRA added a Junior Division for students in Grades 6-8. This program allows our younger students the same opportunities as their High School counterparts and mirrors the High School Division in policy, procedures and rules. As with the High School Division, these members compete all season long and also annually in our Provincial Finals Rodeo in May. The top 4 contestants in each Jr High Event after our Provincial Finals may go onto the NJRHFR and compete Nationally in June of each year.

JR. Boys Rodeo Events

There are 11 events the Jr Boys can compete in. They are Chute Dogging, Breakaway Roping, Goat Tying, Tie Down Roping, Team Roping, Jr. Steer Riding, Bareback Steer Riding, Saddle Bronc Steer Riding, Ribbon Roping and Light Rifle Competition.

JR. Girls Rodeo Events

There are 7 events the Jr Girls can compete in. They are Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Goat Tying, Breakaway Roping, Team Roping, Ribbon Roping and Light Rifle Competition.
