



**RODEO LOCATION:** Indianapolis, Indiana  
Hoosier Horse Fair – Indiana State Fairgrounds

**DIRECTIONS:**

**I-65 North (from Louisville, KY; Columbus, IN)**  
Take I-65 North to I-70 East to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B) Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

**I-65 South (from Chicago, IL; Lafayette, IN)**  
Take I-65 South to the 38th Street exit. Continue east to the Fairgrounds entrance.

**I-70 East (from St. Louis, MO; Terre Haute, IN)**  
Take I-70 East to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

**I-70 West (from Columbus, OH; Richmond, IN)**  
Take I-70 West to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

**I-69 South (from Detroit, MI; Fort Wayne, IN)**  
I-69 South becomes Binford Boulevard (SR37) which becomes Fall Creek Parkway. The Fairgrounds is located just north of 38th Street on Fall Creek Parkway.

**I-74 West (from Cincinnati, OH)**  
I-74 West (from Cincinnati, OH) Take I-74 West to I-465 North. Take I-465 North to I-70 West to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

Enter at the gate located on Fall Creek Parkway, on block north of 38<sup>th</sup> Street in Indianapolis. If you have a trailer and horses, follow the signs and proceed to the unloading area at the stall barn (this is the swine barn during State Fair). **You will also be charged to park on the grounds. This is a State Fee and not included with your entry ticket.**



## EVENT SCHEDULE:

Contestant Check In – Friday, March 30th from 4 pm to 6 pm (go to the rodeo office for check in – Check in may be available sooner than this time, but if you are in the rodeo performance or slack on Friday night, you must be checked in by 6 pm on Friday.)

Rodeo Performances –     Friday, March 30th at 8 pm  
  Saturday, March 31st at 8 pm  
  Sunday, April 1<sup>st</sup> at 4 pm

Rodeo Slack -             Friday, March 30th (if needed) immediately following the Rodeo Performance  
  Saturday, March 31st (if needed) immediately following the Rodeo Performance

Church Service -        To Be Announced prior to the HHF weekend or at the Rodeo Office that weekend.

## CAMPING INFORMATION:

There is electric available. Camping is collected by the State Fairgrounds staff.

## STALLS INFORMATION:

Stalls are mandatory for all horses on the grounds. Stalls will be assigned by the Hoosier Horse Fair personnel. When you arrive, there should be HHF personnel available at the stall office. You must pay for and reserve your stalls with your entry. Bedding is available through the HHF stall office at \$6 per bag or you may bring your own. Tack stalls are not available unless you reserve one in advance on your entry form (same cost as standard stall).

***If you are traveling from outside the state of Indiana, you must have a current and valid coggins and health paper for each horse. These may be checked by the Hoosier Horse Fair personnel as you arrive and receive your stall or may be checked anytime throughout the weekend. Please have them available!!***

## SHOWER & RESTROOM FACILITY AVAILABILITY:

Both are available on-site.



#### **ENTRY TICKETS:**

Once we receive entry tickets from the Indiana Horse Council, we will work with the Ontario High School Rodeo Association leadership to get these tickets to your members. Tickets are limited, and at this time we are not sure how many we will be able to provide to each contestant. We will provide at least one ticket to each contestant. When you enter the grounds you will be required to present one ticket for each individual in the vehicle or pay admission (last year admission was \$10 per person). If you are staying off the fairgrounds and need to re-enter, you will need another ticket for each individual re-entering. For re-entry, you must see Rod Bowman for additional entry tickets (Rod can be contacted through the rodeo office). Because of the limited number of tickets we will not be giving re-entry tickets for those not staying off grounds, and will only be able to provide 1 re-entry ticket for each day. Again, tickets are limited, but we will do our best to secure tickets for each family member traveling with each contestant.

**You will also be charged to park on the grounds. This is a State Fee and not included with your entry ticket.**

#### **OTHER INFO OF INTEREST:**

Keeping your tack secure is strongly recommended as items (including a saddle) were stolen from some of our members in prior years. This is an open show, and there are hundreds of people in and out all weekend long!!

**There will be an IHSRA Rodeo Office located on the north end of the stall barn. This office is open to all our competitors and their families. If you are need of information and assistance throughout the weekend, go to this office.**

There will be concessions on the grounds, but the food is expensive. To try to help defer some of this cost for our Rodeo Families, the Association will be providing food and drink in the Rodeo Office. We are asking for donations and pitch in dishes throughout the weekend. Drink donations are especially needed for all the janitorial workers!!

The water at the State Fairgrounds is city water, and has an odor. If your horse is particular about it's water, you may want to flavor your water at home ahead of time and bring that same flavoring with you to the HHF.

Dogs are prohibited from being in any of the buildings at all times!!
